What you need to know

We expect all students to be neat, clean, tidy and in full uniform.

TEMPORARY LAPSES

If a student is out of uniform we expect:

- An explanatory email or phone call from a parent/guardian. This communication is to be directed to the Learning Mentor.

REGULAR LAPSES INFRINGEMENT PROCEDURE

1st infringement

Learning Mentor or Learning Community Leader talks to student. Recorded in SIMON as a Level 1 incident. Family is contacted via PAM message.

2nd infringement

Learning Community Leader or Deputy Principal talks to student. Recorded in SIMON as a Level 1 incident. Family is contacted via PAM message and/or phone call.

3rd infringement

Learning Community Leader or Deputy Principal talks to student. Recorded in SIMON as a Level 1 incident. Student may be removed from class, sent home or complete an after school detention. Family is contacted for a support group meeting.

THE BASICS

Students are to wear full uniform on a daily basis. Full uniform consists of items listed above, excluding Physical Education Uniforms.

Physical Education CEW brand uniform items only. No other brand items such as shorts or track pants. Students are to wear PE uniform only on days when they have the subject.

PE shoes: Lace up with appropriate ankle support and cushioning.

PE socks: White sport socks.

NON-UNIFORM ITEMS

- Black socks, baseball / trucker caps and non-CEW beanies
- Hoodies and jumpers over or under uniforms
- No Visible undergarments
- Heavy make-up (A natural look must be maintained)
- Excessive Jewellery (Jewellery may need to be removed for hazard/safety concerns)
- Nose rings (wear a stud or clear retainer)
- Boots or boot style
