We expect all students to be neat, clean, tidy and in full uniform.

TEMPORARY LAPSES

If a student is out of uniform we expect:

• An explanatory email or phone call from a parent/guardian. This communication is to be directed to the Learning Mentor.

REGULAR LAPSES INFRINGEMENT PROCEDURE

1st infringement

Learning Mentor or Learning Community Leader talks to student. Recorded in SIMON as a Level 1 incident. Family is contacted via PAM message.

2nd infringement

Learning Community Leader or Deputy Principal talks to student. Recorded in SIMON as a Level 1 incident. Family is contacted via PAM message and/or phone call.

3rd infringement

Learning Community Leader or Deputy Principal talks to student. Recorded in SIMON as a Level 1 incident. Student may be removed from class, sent home or complete an after school detention. Family is contacted for a support group meeting.

THE BASICS

Students are to wear full uniform on a daily basis. Full uniform consists of items listed above, excluding Physical Education Uniforms.

- **Physical Education** CEW brand uniform items only. No other brand items such as shorts or track pants. Students are to wear PE uniform only on days when they have the subject.
- **PE shoes:** Lace up with appropriate ankle support and cushioning.
- PE socks: White sport socks.

OH&S

- Excessive jewellery may need to be removed when working in technology areas.
- In practical classers hair may need to be tied back for safety reasons.
- Hats must be worn in Term 1 and 4, while outside school buildings, during all breaks. College uniform hats are sun safe with broad, angled brims for the protection of face, neck and ears whilst outside.
- Shoes must be completely black (upper and sole included).
- Shoes must be completely black and fully enclosed for safety in the technology rooms.
- Footwear at school is an important safety item. Families should ensure that student's footwear is safe and appropriate. Enclosed leather footwear is recommended, to provide a sound grip on the floor to prevent accidents such as slips, trips and falls and to protect feet from damage caused by accidents such as falling objects or chemical spillages in areas such as technology and science.
