Student Bus Travel Information

SCHOOL BUS PROGRAM (SBP)

While parents and carers have the primary responsibility for transporting their children to and from school, the School Bus Program (SBP) supports families in rural and regional Victoria by providing eligible students with access to school bus transport.

Eligibility criteria determine a student's priority of access to a school bus service.

- Leneva (***Eligibility requirement:** Students must live more than 1.6 km from the Streets Road Bus Stop to qualify. Students who live within 1.6 km are required to use the public bus service. Information about public bus travel is provided further down this page.)

If you believe your child may be eligible for the SBP, please complete the application form and submit it via email to conveyance@ccw.vic.edu.au or deliver a hard copy to the CCW Reception. We will then send your application to the Bus Coordinator at WSSC for processing.



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Important points to note:

- Seating on the School Bus Program is not guaranteed.
- Students who reside further away from school will take priority over those who reside closer to school – i.e. Yackandandah & Surrounds will take priority over Baranduda.
- You will receive correspondence from the Bus Coordinator regarding confirmation, bus allocation and waitlists in the weeks leading up to the first day of Term 1 2027.
- School Bus Program is not designed to accommodate students requiring 'one off' or just in case travel. Please ensure that your child will be travelling regularly. If this changes, please notify us as soon as possible.
- Ensure that you have a backup travel option as waitlists are possible. If your child is placed on a waitlist, we may not be able to confirm bus allocations until after Term 1 has commenced.

PUBLIC BUS TRAVEL - YOUTH MYKI CARD

Public transport is currently free under the Victorian government for children under 18 years. Youth myki is available for a one-off purchase for \$5.
